School Pictures and ID Badges

All students must have their picture taken for school purposes. Photos will be taken on the Student Check-In days - which are August 23rd from 9 AM- 1 PM for new & returning middle school students and August 24th from 9 AM- 1 PM for new & returning high school students. Students who do not check-in on these days will have the opportunity to have their picture taken on a "make-up" picture day scheduled for Friday, October 6th. Student ID badges will be provided to students. ASB cards are required for students who will be participating in clubs or leadership roles and can be purchased on student check in days. All students must have their ID badge available while at school or at a school function and be able to produce it when asked. Students are welcome to use a school appropriate lanyard for their ID badges. A replacement fee for an ID badge or ASB card is \$3.00.
