Dear Parents/Guardians:

WSUV requires all visitors to pay for parking year round Monday through Friday between 7 am and 7 pm. If you will be in the building for less than 2 hours, for the most convenience, you may want to park at the meters in the GREEN 3 parking lot which is close by the Clark College building where iTech is housed. Please bring change to put into the meter when parking; the max is 2 hours @ \$1.50 per hour.

An alternative is to park in the BLUE parking lot in which you can pay with exact cash or credit card.

You may also drive around the campus to the Physical Plant Building, park, go inside, and pay for a day pass for \$5 or purchase an on-line daily permit.

If you don't mind a walk, an alternative is to park for free up to 30 minutes in Visitor Parking located on the north side of the Student Services Center which is in the center of the ORANGE 3 lot. Activation of the time is required to display the complimentary 30 minutes on the meter.

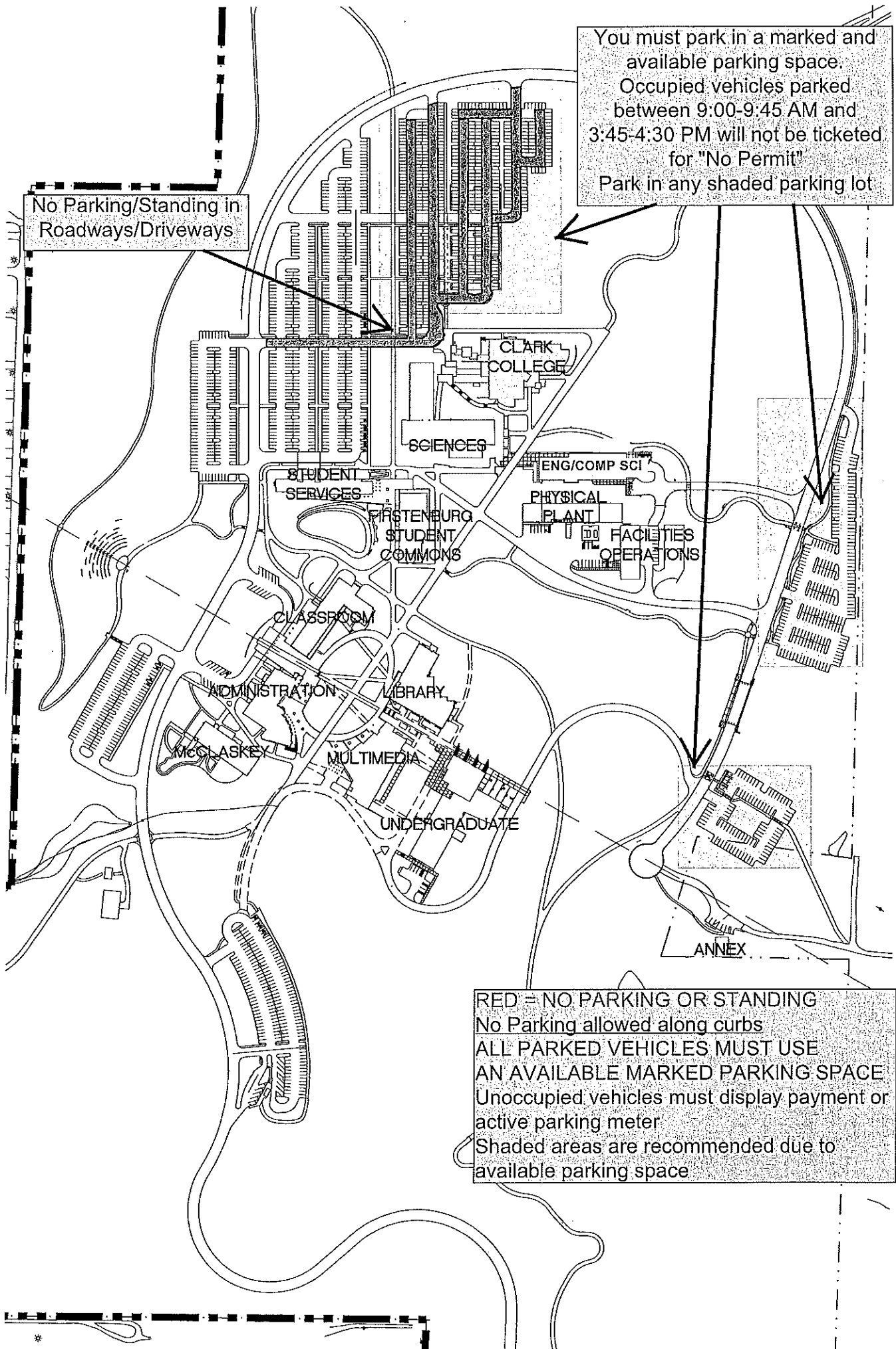
One other free 30 minute location is on the west side of the Administration and Classroom buildings in the bus loop.

WSUV security patrols the parking lots. If a car is parked without a pass, or not paid for at a meter, then you will be ticketed \$35 by WSUV. If the ticket is not paid within 30 days, then an additional \$25 fee is added. More details on parking can be found on-line at <http://admin.vancouver.wsu.edu/parking/parking-services>.

No Parking/Standing in Roadways/Driveways

You must park in a marked and available parking space.  
Occupied vehicles parked between 9:00-9:45 AM and 3:45-4:30 PM will not be ticketed for "No Permit"  
Park in any shaded parking lot

RED = NO PARKING OR STANDING  
No Parking allowed along curbs  
ALL PARKED VEHICLES MUST USE AN AVAILABLE MARKED PARKING SPACE  
Unoccupied vehicles must display payment or active parking meter  
Shaded areas are recommended due to available parking space
